Listening to God's Word

Use the NIV Audio Bible (free on YouTube) to listen to a New Testament epistle together. Share with each other your thoughts after listening and let this lead you into a time of prayer.

Bible Study: Reading the Bible in Three Dimensions

Read Mark Chapter 5 and think about how the Bible speaks to us as we adopt different positions for hearing God's word.

Consider this passage from:

- The "Reformation Position": what does this passage speak to you as an individual?
- The "Liberation Position": what does this passage speak to us as a people?
- The "Liturgical Position": what does this passage speak to us as a church?
